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Residential Building Permit Submittal Checklist

Please include all items listed on the checklist when submitting a Residential Building Permit. Permits will not be accepted or reviewed until the checklist is complete. Drawings must be drawn to scale, dimensioned and of sufficient clarity.

Required Drawings and Documents:

- ___ 1. **Complete Residential Permit Application**
- ___ 2. **Construction Document Submittals:** Two (2) Copies and One (1) Digital copy of complete set of construction documents are required for plan review
- ___ 3. **Site Plan:** drawn to scale of 1" = 20' or legible with dimensions (not to scale). Site plans must show lot dimensions, footprint of building and distance from building to property lines, platted building lines, driveways, all easements, water courses, ditches, direction of water runoff, and the address and legal description of the lot.
- ___ 4. **Erosion control:** Plan showing silt fences and rock filter dams to prevent erosion.
- ___ 5. **Exterior elevations**
- ___ 6. **Floor Plans:** drawn to a scale of 1/4" = 1'. Floor plans must show all dimensions, room names, size and type of windows and doors, roof slopes, chimneys, and overhangs.
- ___ 7. **Structural plans:** where required, drawn to a scale of 1/4" = 1'. Structural plans must show second floor framing, ceiling framing, roof framing, headers and beams.
- ___ 8. **Electrical Plans:** (may be combined with the floor plan) drawn to a scale of 1/4" = 1'. Electrical plans must show the location of receptacles and other outlets, exhaust fans, smoke detectors, light fixtures, service equipment and panels.
- ___ 9. **Plumbing plans:** (may be combined with the floor plan) drawn to a scale of 1/4" = 1' or legible with dimensions. Plumbing plans show the location of fixtures, water heaters, and gas outlets.
- ___ 10. **Mechanical plans:** (may be combined with the floor plan) drawn to a scale of 1/4" = 1' or legible with dimensions. Mechanical plans show the location of A/C and heating units, appliances and duct work.
